



<u>International Carp Team Trial</u>

Condition 1

The trial will be fished under CIPS/FIPS code of conduct and regulations.

Full details of these are available at: - www.cips-fips.com/cips/index en.html

All anglers who finish in the top 15 will take part in a fish off and skills trial for the final team positions. (This will be arranged at during May and June to fit in around the current arranged matches.)

All anglers taking part must be members of the WFCA (either club or individual).

These event will be arranged through the Welsh Federation of coarse Anglers.

The World Carp Championship is to be held on: - Lake Deseda Hungry – information of the venue can be found at:- http://www.deseda.hu/en

The match will take place including travel from the 23rd to the 30th of September. (the practice will be arranged when the team has been choosen.)

Condition 2

You must fully commit to the following:-

- 1. Are you able to commit approximately 12 days plus of you annual holidays for practice and
- 2. Be willing to travel to a central location once a month to attend a Team meeting at your own time and cost.
- 3. Each team member will need to cover the full cost of their own expenses (Travel, bait, food) for both international and practice matches. (You may need to step up your fishing gear as well depending on the event location)
- 4. Work as part of a team, including instructions from the Manager and Captain.
- 5. Follow the rules governing conduct as set by CIPS/FIPS and WFCA.

International Carp Team Trial

Provisional Costs per man

- 1. Ferry crossing £100 per man
- 2. Camp site cost (this will end up as base camp for the match for 1week) £120 per man.
- 3. Entry fee £155 per man. (All entry fees are to be paid in advance directly to the WFCA)
- 4. Approximately 2500-mile round trip approximately £450.00 per van (split equally between the van occupants)
- 5. Van hire if required is approximately £600 per van per week (split equally between the van occupants) Unless you have access to a van
- 6. Bait required 100kg per man average cost at £5 per kg £500
- 7. Health and travel insurance £40 per man(Compulsory)
- 8. One night Hotel to rest on a 2-day journey £60 per man with breakfast.
- 9. Toll costs £235 per van (split equally between the van occupants)
- 10. Food and drink approximately £25.00 per day.

Average costs per man per trip to Hungry will be in the region of £1,462.00 we are planning to go over twice including the practice.

Please note the above costs are only a guideline.

You may be required to fish in other matches throughout the year representing the WFCA team.
